REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES

The City of St. Marys was awarded a KDOT Surface Preservation grant. The project was estimated at \$455,865, and the City is requesting proposals for the provision of engineering consultant services in connection with the work.

Project Location:

The project is located on Bertrand Avenue (US-24) from approximately the west City Limits of St. Marys through N. 6th Street (K-63).

Project Scope:

The project consists of a mill/overlay with pavement patching and replacement of pavement markings. The project also includes the removal and replacement of the north intersection apron of the US-24 and K-63 intersection pavement with durable concrete pavement.

Required Services:

Required services consist of developing project cost estimates, suggestions for options to reduce cost and/or improve project, engineering design and inspection, construction staking, and project completion and follow-up. Project design shall be in conformity with the State of Kansas and Federal design criteria appropriate for the project, in accordance with the current manuals, policies, and memos adopted by the Kansas Secretary of Transportation. KDOT standard drawings shall be employed.

Proposals:

Proposals shall include qualifications of project personnel, a description of project scope and methodology, scheduling, cost of services, a description of experience with similar projects and at least three municipal references with respect to similar work.
